Our course crosses three high mountains passes: Dochula at 3100m, Pelela at 3300m and Yotongla, the most noteworthy at 3,400m. Bumthang is viewed as the profound home of the Bhutanese individuals. The whole Bumthang valley is specked with the absolute most established authentic landmarks and Nyes (consecrated spots) in all of Bhutan, some going back to the seventh century A.D., a time of which there is minimal present day learning. This visit likewise goes to Paro, Thimphu, Punakha, Wangdue and Trongsa. Other than these goals, we additionally incorporate features, for example, a visit to the Gangtey valley to recognize the Black-Necked Crane. This uncommon winged animal is an imperiled species that relocates in winter from the level of Tibet and Siberia.
