Moreover, our trekking towards dazzling Sherpa town of Namche Bazar is exceptional, Namche Bazaar itself a standout amongst the most significant villages of Khumbu regions, it's a little wonderful village with remarkable mountains views on the Himalayas and it's where you will appreciate the interesting society and convention of local Sherpa individuals. Namche is notable as a capital of Everest region though you find a wide range of sorts of trading with verities of home item and Namche have numerous offices giving atm services and quality trekking and climbing bits of equipment gears.

In Namche Bazaar we essentially take an acclimatization day for our journey, subsequent to having rest day in Namche than we climb towards our goal for next couple of days experiences the Tengboche which is well-famous religious community situated at 4035m, the most highest monastery in Khumbu region, Khumjung and Khunde villages which are outstanding as twin Sherpa town of Khumbu area. The spot is the completely astounding spot to get the views on Everest (8848m), Lhotse (8516m), Nuptse (7861m), Ama Dablam (6812m) Thamserku (6623m) and some more.

Everest Panorama view trek is one of the exciting short experience trekking goals which can be fit for any sort of age groups; this trek is sincerely intended for travellers who wish to have a superb encounter of the powerful mountain while trekking in the Himalayas in a brief timeframe with no difficulties. Outline Day to Day Itinerary:

Day 01: Landing at Kathmandu 1350m/4428ft.

Upon your landing in Tribhuvan International air terminal, you will be seeing our representatives and transfer to your lodging for your overnight stay at best possible available Hotel.

Day 02: Kathmandu valley Tour.

Today we explore the excellent Kathmandu valley. Our visit guide will bring you into the Kathmandu valley for sightseeing. Where you will visit: Pashupatinath Temple, Bauddhanath Stupa, and Bhaktapur Durbar-square.

Day 03: Fly from Kathmandu to Lukla (2610m) and 3 hrs trek to Phakding (2810m).

We will have early breakfast at the hotel and starts short drive to Kathmandu domestic airport, checking in our tickets to the airplane terminal then we take a beautiful trip to Lukla about 35minutes. We are presently in the place where there is Sherpa people group; after coming to Lukla our staffs will give you a chance to present with our team who will convey your baggage's whole trek we step ahead after the Dudkosi River up to the elevated zone. We will ascend through the Sherpa villages of Chhupulung, Ghat and afterward comes to Phakding, offers some lofty and stunning view on mountains.

Day 04: Trek from Phakding to Namche 3,450m/11,315ft- 6 hrs.

Today we head off from Phakding to Namche Bazaar, then we will be proceed strolled through the Sherpa village along the bank of Dudhkoshi river, we are walking through rhododendron, fir, Himalayan pine, cedar woods observing beautiful mountain of Kusum kangaroo and Thamserku. The trail is bloomed as we cross the high suspension bridge while moving through the dense forest than passing the views where we can see first Mt. Everest seen. As you arrive NamcheBazzar a town is surrounded by amazing mountains.

Day 05: Rest and acclimatization.

Today is the day that we will adapt at Namche Bazaar; it is a perfect spot to go through multi day for acclimatization to the high elevation before heading towards Tyangboche. We wish to explore the Sherpa town including the ancient monastery, Sherpa museum and Everest art gallery, mountain bread shop with Sherpa tea and free WIFI around in the town while dealing with our opportunity to explore the yak farm, Everest view and world highest airport at that day.

Day 06: Trek from Namche to Tengboche 3,860m/12,677ft- 4/5hrs.

After having breakfast, we begin our short trek on the flat land level obsrerving breathtaking panoramic mountain views of Thamserku, Kantega, Amadoblam, Lhotse, Everest, and Kusum Kanguru. Following 2 hours stroll on the same level then you will descend from steep mountain to a river and reach at Phunki Tenga, after pass through Rhododendron and pines forest to the Tyangbuche, and visit the monastery and observe the view.

Day 07: Trek from Tengbuche to Khumjun/Khunde 3900m/12792ft- 5 hrs.

After having breakfast, we continue a similar trail that we came up following couple of hours and descend to Phungitenga then trek begin moving up in the pine forest to Khumjung town while moving up to ridge the valley we will get a chance to observe the beautiful landscape once more, an incredible perspective on Himalayas. Coming to Khumjung village then we go to visit the Hillary school kept running by Edmund Hillary establishments, Yeti skull which is securely kept in Khumjung Monastery and Proceed with our trek to Kunde.

Day 08: Trek from Khumjung to Manjo 2800m/9185ft- 5 hrs.

Visiting twin sherpa towns (Khumjung and Kunde) and then our lovely climbing go down to Namche and Manjo villages through the yak farm and observing magnificent snowcapped on backgrounds.

Going down hills we get a chance to catch a stunning view of Mt. Everest before coming to Manjo town.

Day 09: Trek from Manju to Lukla 2800m/9185ft- 4hrs

After breakfast at our hotel. we have a short stroll to Lukla and it's the latest day of our Everest Panorama see Trek, the trekking is wonderful and for the most part on the flat level and at end of the trek we have ascend up of 30 minutes to Lukla..

Day 10: Fly from Lukla to Kathmandu 35 minutes.

Today we will take early breakfast at Lukla then we will fly from here to Kathmandu, then transfer to your hotel in Kathmandu, After having effectively completed Everest Panorama trek you will get a chance to enjoy good meals, internet, coffee and stroll around the street of Thamel.

Day 11: Final Departure/Farewell.

Today is the final day of our trip. You will never forget the lifetime experience and those momentum. On that day, our agent will drop you to the Airport 3 hours before your planned flight. We wish for your safe and great flight. Hope See you next time.

Please Note: The cloud and turbulent weather is a regular phenomenon along the Himalayan range. It is thus possible that domestic flights from Kathmandu to/from Lukla may have to be delayed for a few hours or even cancelled for a day or more. Fortunately, this does not happen frequently during the high seasons of March to May or September to November: but you need to plan for this possibility.

As a safeguard, we recommend that you add on a couple of extra days after your trek before you fly from Kathmandu to your onward destination.
