Trip Introduction

Marshyangdi River Rafting considered as a standout amongst the best white water travels on the planet; this 35 km boating activity on Marshyangdi waterway can take as long as 2 days. The **Marshyangdi River Rafting** begins from 'Bhulbhule', which is around 5-6 hours drive from west of Kathmandu. The view seeing during the trek is consistently changing going from mountains, thick woods, open valleys to little ethnic towns, making it amazingly energizing and extraordinary. The waterway seethes through limited crevasses and ravines and past staggering Annapurna Mountains.

The difficult evaluation 4 to 5-rapids start on the very first moment and are for all intents and purposes nonstop to the take-out point, with steep, specialized and exciting rides through Himalayan view.

The **Marshyangdi** (or **Marsyangdi**) (<u>Nepali</u>: मस्याङ्दी, marśyāṅdī) is a mountain river in <u>Nepal</u>. Its length is about 150 kilometres.

The Marshyangdi begins at the confluence of two mountain rivers, the Khangsar Khola and Jharsang Khola, northwest of the <u>Annapurna massif</u> at an altitude of 3600 meters near <u>Manang</u> village. The Marshyangdi flows eastward through <u>Manang District</u> and then southward through <u>Lamjung District</u>.

The Marshyangdi joins the <u>Trishuli</u> near <u>Mugling</u> as one of its tributaries.

The beginning of the Annapurna Circuit trekking route follows the Marshyangdi river valley.

Outline Itinenary

- **Day 01**: Drive from Kathmandu to Dumre to Besisahar by bus or truck, whatever available. Overnight camping at Besisahar. (B.L.D)

- Day 03: All day rafting and camping on the beach near Turtle Bazaar. (B.L.D)
