Siklis Tour is a pleasant trek that unfurls the common magnificence of Nepal. The beguiling towns, captivating examples of terraced fields, rhododendron woodlands, high snow capped glades settled beneath the transcending piles of Annapurna II and IV are a portion of the key highlights of Siklis Tek. Sikles Trek 4 days 3 nights is a quiet trail with few trekkers. It offers a stunning trek experience and amazing views, with very basic facilities along the trail.

The Siklis Trek course takes you to the locale which is possessed by the Gurung people group maintaining their well established traditions and customs. A last high point uncovers eminent perspectives on the fish-tail pinnacle or privately known as Machapuchare.

Siklis Tour likewise offers feathered creature darlings a genuine treat as there are assortments of types of fowls which are found in bounty in the timberlands of the Siklis district. Sikles Village comprises of 850 households, mostly Gurung, located on the ridge of a hill. It overlooks stunning snow-peaked mountains such as Lamjung Himal (6,983 m / 22,910 ft), Annapurna III (7,555 m / 24,787 ft), IV (7,524 m / 24,685 ft) & Lanjung (6,983 m/ 22,910 ft). Outline Itinerary

- **Day 01** :Kathmandu Arrival.
- **Day 02** :Drive from Kathmandu to Pokhara (914m.) takes about seven hours.
- **Day 03** :Drive from Pokhara to Bijayapur Khola (Bijayapur Army Camp)-Kalikasthan (1370m.) which takes about five hours.
- **Day 04** :Trek from Kalikasthan to LamaKhet (1680m.) which takes about six hours.
- **Day 05** :Trek from Lama Khet to Siklis (1980m.) which takes approximately six hours.
- **Day 06** :Trek from Siklis to Neuli Kharka or Forest camp (2200m.) which takes about five hours.
- **Day 07** :Trek from Forest Camp to Ghale Gaon (2000m.) which takes about five hours.

- **Day 08** :Trek from Ghale Gaon to Pokhara which takes about three hours.
- **Day 09** :Drive from Pokhara to Kathmandu which takes about seven hours.
- **Day 10** :Final Departure/Farewell.

- All above trekking hours and distances are approximate and it's absolutely for general ideas only.
- The above data is a guide and standard layout of what we give. Our trek can be customized at your request to suit your particular necessities
